Member Benefit: Permission-free use of translated terminology content for non-commercial purposes

As members of the Dietisternas Riksförbund you are entitled to use, for non-commercial research and educational purposes, portions of the translated Swedish eNCPT content without obtaining permission in advance, and at no cost.

The below checklist provides guidance when considering if you are reprinting content under the fair use member benefit:

1. Determine purpose and character of the Use

- ✓ Non-profit Educational Institution
- ✓ Teaching/Educational purpose (includes multiple print copies for classroom use)
- ✓ Research/Scholarship/Newsletters*
- ✓ Clinical Work
- ✓ Quality Improvement Data Sets
- ✓ Presentations
- ✓ Personal Study
- ✓ Swedish Translated content only

*If you are using portions of eNCPT within an article submitted to a professional journal, you may be required by the publisher to provide documentation of permission. Please provide the publisher with a copy of, or link to, this page.

2. Amount of Portion Used

- \checkmark Small portion of work is used.
- Portion used is not central or significant to the entire work as a whole (eg, it does not replace the original work)
- \checkmark Portion used is not more than is necessary for your purpose.
- \checkmark Swedish translation content

3. Proper citation

In all instances of content reproduction, proper citation is required. See below:

Content on eNCPT can be cited the same way that you cite other web references. Citations for online sources should provide information that allows the source to be located and retrieved again. Refer to the appropriate standard for your discipline and context. Below, you can find examples of citations in the American Medical Association style:
